

ATTENTION!

Dear resident,

As stated in the current federal law, when entering Germany from a COVID19 high-risk country as classified by the Robert-Koch-Institute (QR CODE →), you have to follow some **rules**:



- Until you are **proven negative** by a test that you are not infected with the Sars-CoV2-Virus, you have to **isolate yourself**. This means, that you have to **stay in your flat until you got a negative test result** from a COVID19-test.

This test has to be done **within 72 hours after entry**.

- **Always** wear mouth-nose-protection **on the floor and in the common rooms**. This is to protect others!
- Make sure to only enter the common rooms (**kitchen and bath**) when absolutely necessary, **ALONE** and wearing a mask all the time. When entering, **flip the sign at the door**, so others know that it is occupied. When leaving a common room, make sure to **open the windows for 3-5 minutes** to ventilate the room and reverse the status-sign so others may use the room. Also **clean the surfaces with appropriate cleaning**.
